性別、階級與族群 Gender, Class and Ethnicity

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授課時間：週三 上午 9:10-12:00

課程大綱

一九八零年代，黑人女性主義與第三世界女性主義從邊緣的社會地位出發，激進地挑戰著以歐美白人中產階級為主的女性主義論述，她們以性別、階級與族群交織的觀點，重寫了女性主義者看待社會的觀點，詮釋社會中各種權力之共時運作。要如何以性別、階級與族群交織的觀點看社會？本課程先介紹交織政治的理論脈絡，而後以交織政治作為理論，同時也作為研究法，展示在移民議題、原住民議題及性議題上，交織政治的實証研究如何可以開展出細緻的性別研究空間。

課程目的

培養學生閱讀及分析思考能力為主。在課程結束之後，學生應學到黑人女性主義的精髓，對於性別、階級與族群等多重社會力的運作與壓迫有清晰的洞識。

教學方法

上課前閱讀文本，上課時集體討論，偶爾穿插電影的分析與討論，以多元的授課方式啟發學生以性別階級與族群交織的方式，詮釋邊陲的性別議題。

教科書

無指定教科書。指定讀物為相關領域之論文或書籍之章節。

請準時出席，缺席不超過三次。學生必須勤學，在上課前必須先交一份不超過一頁的摘要，並提出二個問題供全班同學上課討論。

12	<p>Guest Speaker: Jane Hindley 墨西哥例子</p> <p>Indigenous People in Mexico: Ethnicity, Class and Gender</p> <p>This session is about the position of indigenous people in Mexico. It briefly introduces students to the invention of ‘Indians’ at the start of the Spanish Conquest and the system of social classification that became entrenched during the colonial period. It then discusses the impact of Independence in the C19th and attempts to integrate indigenous people in the twentieth century, before moving on to explore indigenous struggles for dignity, recognition and autonomy over the last 20 years. Throughout the session we will also compare the Mexican case with the situation of indigenous people in Taiwan.</p>
13	<p>Guest Speaker : Jane Hindley 墨西哥例子</p> <p>Indigenous Mobilisation and Transformations in Gender Relations in Mexico</p> <p>This session looks at the way how mobilisations for indigenous rights in Mexico over the last twenty years has often in many cases has been accompanied by transformations in gender relations within indigenous communities. It describes the patriarchal norms that predominated in many indigenous regions and goes on to discuss how women ‘earned their rights’ through participating in grassroots political action. It draws on fieldwork carried out by the author in the Nahua region of the Upper Balsas Guerrero during a mobilisation that stopped a large-scale dam, as well as cases from other regions—including the</p>
